Pleurotus ostreatus	Oyster	All seasons, on aspen
Agaricus bitorquis	Spring Agaricus	May-Jun, Sep, Pastures, grassland
Boletus pinophilus	.....	May-Oct, Conifers, pine
Boletus reticulatus	Summer King Bolete	May-Sep, Beech, oak, spruce at higher elevations
Boletus subcaerulescens	.....	May-Oct, Scots pine, spruce
Boletus variipes	.....	May-Oct, Oak, beech, maple, aspen, hemlock, pine, spruce
Calvatia gigantea	Giant Puffball	May-Jul, Aug-Oct, Open woods, pastures, urban areas
Coprinus atramentarius	Alcohol Inky	May-Sep, Lives on buried wood, parks, along roads
Coprinus comatus	Shaggy Mane	May-Jun, Sep-Oct, Hard packed soil
Hygrophorus pratensis	Salmon Waxy Cap	May-Dec, Open places, grassy areas, in woods
Laetiporus sulphureus	Chicken	May-Nov, On trees and stumps.
Marasmius oreades	Fairy Ring Mushroom	May-Sep, Open grass, pine, spruce
Polyporus umbellatus	Umbrella Polypore	May-Oct, On buried wood, by stumps, on trees
Stropharia rugosoannulata	Wine-cap	May-Oct, Cultivated fields, bark mulch
Suillus brevipes	Short-stalked Suillus	May-Jun, 2 or 3 needle pine
Tylopilus chromapes	Chrome-footed Bolete	May-Oct, Aspen, birch
Agaricus arvensis	Horse Mushroom	Jun-Oct, meadows/fields/and grassy waste areas/spruce
Agaricus campestris	Meadow Mushroom	Jun-Sep, grassy areas
Armillariella mellea	Honey Mushroom	Jun-Nov, at base of stumps or trees
Boletus auripes	.....	Jun-Nov, oak/beach/
Boletus bicolor	Two-colored Bolete	Jun-Oct, under oaks
Boletus edulis	King Bolete	Jun-Oct, conifers/spruce
Cantharellus cinnabarinus	Cinnabar-red Chanterelle	Jun-Oct, borders of grassy oak woods
Clavicornia pyxidata	Crown-tipped Coral	Jun-Sep, aspen/willow
Gomphidius subroseus	Rosy Gomphidius	Jun-Nov, fir/hemlock
Grifola umbellata	.....	Jun-Jul, near the bases and roots of hardwoods
Gyroporus castaneus	Chestnut Bolete	Jun-Oct, hardwood forests
Hygrophorus sordidus	.....	Jun-Oct, open grassy oak groves, bottom of slope
Laccaria laccata	Common Laccaria	Jun-Nov, everywhere
Lactarius volemus	Voluminous-latex Milky	Jun-Sep, grassy oak woods
Leccinum insigne	Aspen Scaber Stalk	Jun-Sep, under aspen
Lepiota Americana	Reddening Lepiota	Jun-Oct, on decayed hardwood stumps/sawdust
Lycoperdon pyriforme	Pear-shaped Puffball	Jun-Nov, woody debris
Lyophyllum decastes	Fried-chicken Mushroom	Jun-Oct, in clusters in grassy areas/waste places/roads
