Armillariella mellea	Honey Mushroom	Jun-Nov, at base of stumps or trees
Boletus auripes	Jun-Nov, oak/beach/
Boletus bicolor	Two-colored Bolete	Jun-Oct, under oaks
Boletus edulis	King Bolete	Jun-Oct, conifers/spruce
Cantharellus cinnabarinus	Cinnabar-red Chanterelle	Jun-Oct, borders of grassy oak woods
Gomphidius subroseus	Rosy Gomphidius	Jun-Nov, fir/hemlock
Gyroporus castaneus	Chestnut Bolete	Jun-Oct, hardwood forests
Hygrophorus sordidus	Jun-Oct, open grassy oak groves, bottom of slope
Laccaria laccata	Common Laccaria	Jun-Nov, everywhere
Lepiota Americana	Reddening Lepiota	Jun-Oct, on decayed hardwood stumps/sawdust
Lycoperdon pyriforme	Pear-shaped Puffball	Jun-Nov, woody debris
Lyophyllum decastes	Fried-chicken Mushroom	Jun-Oct, in clusters in grassy areas/waste places/roads
Phylloporus rhodoxanthus	Gilled Bolete	Jun-Oct, under conifers in mixed woods
Polyozellus multiplex	Clustered Blue Chanterelle	Jun-Oct, rare, spruce/fir
Russula mariae	Purple Bloom Russula	Jun-Oct, oak/grassy areas under oak
Suillus granulatus	Dotted-stalk Suillus	Jun-Nov. under pine/hemlock/spruce
Suillus pictus	Painted Suillus	Jun-Nov, eastern white pine
Tylopilus eximius	Lilac-brown Bolete	Jun-Oct, hemlock/spruce/balsam fir
Xanthoconium separans	Jun-Oct, under oak/pine/mixed conifers
Agaricus abruptibulbus	Abruptly-bulbous Agaricus	Jul-Oct, in mixed woods
Amanita caesarea	American Caesar's Mushroom	Jul-Oct, dry pine and oak woods
Amanita calyptroderma	Coccora	Jul-Oct, fir and oak
Armillaria caligata	Fragrant Armillaria	Jul-Oct, oak
Calvatia cyathiformis	Purple-spored Puffball	Jul-Nov, grass/park/pastures
Cantharellus tubaeformis	Trumpet Chanterelle	Jul-Oct, on moss in bogs
Dentinum repandum	Sweet Tooth	Jul-Nov, conifer, hardwood forest
Fistulina hepatica	Beefsteak Polypore	Jul-Oct, at base of oak
Hypomyces lactifluorum	Lobster Mushroom	Jul-Oct, open/oak/aspen/beach/maple
Laccaria ochropurpurea	Purple-gilled Laccaria	Jul-Nov, hardwood/thin/hard-pack soil
Lactarius subpurpureus	Variegated Milky	Jul-Oct, hemlock, pine

Lycoperdon perlatum	Gem-studded Puffball	Jul-Oct, open woods, road, urban areas
Russula variata	Variable Russula	Jul-Oct, oak, aspen
Sparassis crispa	Eastern Cauliflower Mushroom	Jul-Oct, open/oak/sandy/oak/pine
Suillus intermedius	Jul-Oct, moss, pine
Suillus neoalbidipes	Jul-Oct, sandy soil under pine
Suillus pictus	Painted Suillus	Jun-Nov, white pine
Suillus placidus	White Suillus	Jul-Oct, white pine
Volvariella bombycina	Tree Volvaria	Jul-Oct, wounded deciduous trees
Armillaria ponderosa	White Matsutake	Aug-Nov, coastal areas, sandy/conifers
Boletus mirabilis	Admirable Bolete	Aug-Nov, by rotting logs of fir/hemlock
Calvatia craniformis	Skull-shaped Puffball	Aug-Oct, open woods by oak
Cantharellula umbonata	Grayling	Aug-Nov, in haircap moss
Cantharellus clavatus	Pig's Ears	Aug-Dec, conifer forests
Catathelasma ventricosa	Swollen-stalked Cat	Aug-Oct, conifer forests, spruce, fir
Clavariadelphus truncatus	Flat-topped Coral	Aug-Oct, cedar and hemlock stands
Clitocybe nuda	Blewit	Aug-Dec, hardwood/conifer/grass/ woody debris
Entoloma abortivum	Aborted Entoloma	Aug-Dec, low hardwood/decaying logs
Gomphus clavatus	Pig's Ear Gomphus	Aug-Oct, conifers, spruce fir
Hericium coralloides	Bear's Head Tooth	Aug-Nov, logs/stumps, wounded tree, maple/beech
Hericium erinaceus	Bearded Tooth	Aug-Nov, living trees/oak/maple beech
Hericium ramosum	Comb Tooth	Aug-Oct, decaying maple/beech/birch
Lactarius deliciosus	Orange-latex Milky	Aug-Oct, under pine/conifers
Naematoloma capnoides	Smoky-gilled Naematoloma	Aug-Nov, clustered on conifer wood
Ramaria botrytis	Clustered Coral	Aug-Oct, under conifers/spruce/fir
Suillus subluteus	Slippery Jill	Aug-Dec, under 2 or 3 needle pine
Tricholoma flavovirens	Canary Trich	Aug-Nov, pine in sandy areas
Agaricus subrufescens	Sep-Dec, organic debris
Armillariella tabescens	Ringless Honey Mushroom	Sep-Nov, clusters at base of tree
Cortinarius armillatus	Bracelet Cort	Sep-Oct, woods, birch
Grifola frondosa	Hen of the Woods	Sep-Nov, base of oak, stumps
Hygrophorus russula	Russulalike Waxy Cap	Sep-Oct, with oak
Lepiota naucina	Smooth Lepiota	Sep-Oct, grassy areas
Lepiota rachodes	Shaggy Parasol	Sep-Oct, along roads, garden
Pholiota aurivella	Golden Pholiota	Sep-Nov, clustered on living trunks, logs/maple/elm/beech/birch
Pholiota mutabilis	Changing Pholiota	Sep-Nov, clustered on logs and stumps
Pholiota squarrosoides	Sharp-scale Pholiota	Sep-Oct, clustered on birch/beech/maple
Pleurocybella porrigens	Angel Wings	Sep-Oct, decaying pine/hemlock
Ramaria araiospora	Light Red Coral	Sep-Nov, spruce, fir, pine
Rozites caperata	Gypsy	Sep-Nov, forests
Suillus cavipes	Hollow-stalked Larch Suillus	Sep-Oct, larch
Suillus luteus	Slippery Jack	Sep-Dec, red pine spruce
Hypholoma sublateritium	Brick Tops	Oct-Dec, stumps and logs
Panellus serotinus	Late Fall Oyster	Oct-Nov, stumps and logs
Tricholoma portentosum	Sticky Gray Trich	Oct-Nov, pine and oak
